

HUDA Clinic first opened its doors in May 2004 to serve the uninsured population of the Detroit area. When it began, the HUDA Clinic provided solely medical services. We then moved from our original facility at the Muslim Center of Detroit into a new, larger facility on Woodrow Wilson Street. Since then, we have expanded our care to include a full range of dental, podiatry, vision services, and mental health services, as well as a plethora of specialty services available at no-cost to our patients.



The HUDA Clinic began because of the committed efforts of volunteers, and we continue to succeed in serving our community through volunteerism.

Along with providing health care to the uninsured and underinsured population of Metro-Detroit, HUDA Clinic strives to engage pre-health students with experience in their prospective field. HUDA volunteers are provided with the opportunity to volunteer in both clinical and non-clinical settings. Volunteers work with medical professionals in various specialties, providing them with a unique insight into medicine!

OUR GROWTH OVER THE YEARS

Through the generosity of our volunteer physicians and health professionals, we have been able to expand our services provided at no cost to our patients, especially in 2019! Here is a brief snapshot of our services:



Primary Care

Primary care providers are typically the first line of contact for patients; treating general health concerns, providing education, medications and specialty referrals as needed. We provide preventative primary care services in a person-focused community health clinic.

Pharmacy

Our clinic features and in-house pharmacy, providing much needed medications to our patients at no cost to them. In 2019, we dispensed 4,928 medications to our patients! Our pharmacy is made possible through our generous donors and community organizations

Vision Care

Vision screenings is an effective method to identify individuals with visual impairment or eye conditions that are likely to lead to vision loss. We perform screenings in-house and provide no-cost eye wear and referrals to low-cost local ophthalmologists as needed.

Dental Care


Many people wait to have necessary dental work done because they don't have insurance, however small dental problems can quickly become incredibly painful if left alone. We provide cleanings, restorative procedures, extractions, exams, and provide referrals to a specialist if needed.

Mental Health

We have volunteer psychiatrists and licensed social workers to provide therapy and treatment for a wide range of mental health concerns. We offer free counseling and treatment to veterans, homeless, uninsured, and the working underinsured.

Specialty Services

In 2019, we were able to add on an array of free services to our patients, listed on the next page. We are excited as more and more physicians and providers dedicated their time towards providing their services to our patients. This allows HUDA to provide comprehensive and quality care!



Over the years, HUDA Clinic has added on many services. We began with primary care, and have since included a plethora of services, all made possible by physicians and health professionals willing to dedicate their time.

The addition of specialty services allows HUDA Clinic to provide comprehensive and quality care for our patients. Additionally, Medicaid enrollment is vital in helping our patients transition to sustainable healthcare that they deserve. We provides these patients with care in the interim, and help them get enrolled into programs they despartely need and have been unable to attain.

OUR DEMAND IN RECENT YEARS

For over 15 years, HUDA Clinic has been relied on by hundreds of patients across Metro-Detroit. Despite an increase in insurance coverage over the recent years, there continues to exist gaps in the healthcare system that make basic health care inaccessible for some. As such, HUDA has seen a continued increase in demand for free services. Below is a snapshot of our monthly patient visits for the past five years.



We continue to see an increase in our patient numbers in recent years. Not only are we expanding our capacity to see patients, we are also responding to a continued need for our services. In the coming years, we hope to further expand our services to ensure our patients are able to recieve the comprehensive and compassionate care they deserve.


